Union S.S. Co.: Ngatoro, ss, is at Devonport loading cement, produce, and timber for Sydney. She will clear for Burnie to-day to complete loading for Sydney.

Howard Smith Line: Time, ss, arrived at Burnie on Saturday night from Geelong with a cargo of superphosphate and paper pulp. After discharging at Burnie, she will sail for Devonport, where she will discharge and load, and return to Burnie to complete her cargo for Melbourne.

Tasmanian Steamers Pty. Ltd.: Tarcoona, tss, will arrive at Burnie at 6 o'clock to-morrow morning, with passengers, mails and general cargo from Melbourne. She will sail on return at 8 o'clock in the evening.

Holyman Line: Tambar, ss, sailed from Devonport for Ulverstone on Saturday morning after discharging explosives from Melbourne. The vessel arrived at Ulverstone that afternoon, and will load there and at Stanley before clearing for Melbourne.

Woniara, ss, arrived at Burnie yesterday from Melbourne. She will discharge, and then proceed to Devonport to discharge and load. The vessel will complete loading for Melbourne at Stanley.

J. S. Lee and Sons: Coomonry, aux. sch., sailed from Smithton for Melbourne on Saturday with a cargo of timber.
